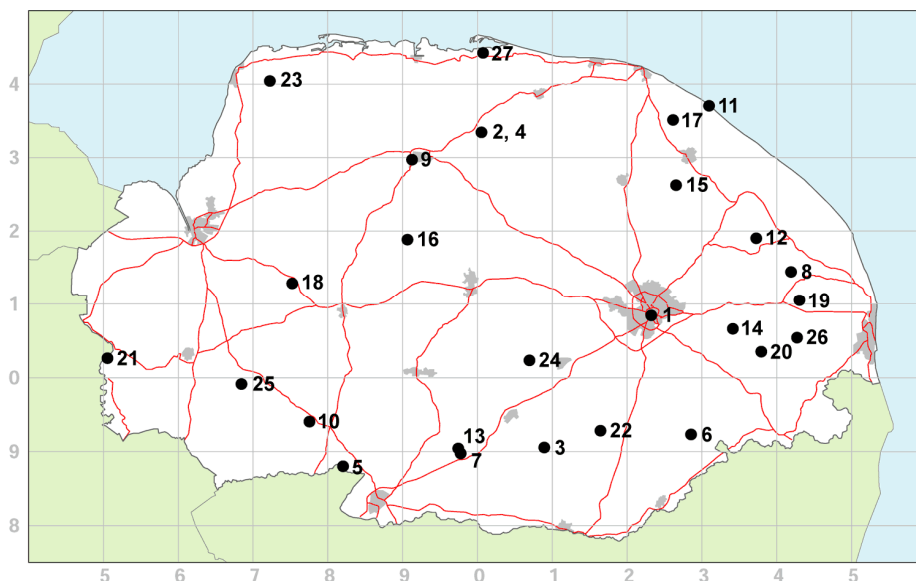
Joint Programme of Field Meetings 2007

All meetings start at 10.30 except Sat 28th July

Thu April 19	TG 232 084 Shire Hall, Norwich Herbarium Workshop With Tony Irwin and Bob Leaney. The study centre entrance is next door to the Regimental Museum in Market Street. A workshop on collecting and preserving specimens and use of the herbarium in the morning. Coffee will be available from 10am. There will be a chance to examine herbarium specimens and use the library in the afternoon. (1)	Tue May 8	TG 005 334 Guybon's Wood (and if time, Briningham Plantation) Guybon's Wood adjoins the Swanton woods. Meet in a lay-by on the <i>south</i> side of the B1354. (4)
Sat April 28	TG 004 335 Middle and Great Heath Plantations, Thursford Park in a lay-by on the north side of the B1354. Unknown territory but once formed part of Stock Heath which ran at least to Guist. (2)	Sun May 13	TL 820 880 Santon NNNS 'Wildflowers Revealed' meeting. Park N. of the railway in the parking area. We shall be moving for the afternoon. (5)
Fri May 4	TM 089 905 New Buckenham <i>Orchis morio</i> sites. New Buckenham, Gissing & Boyland Commons; Shelfhanger meadows & tetrad TM18G. We will be splitting up and mostly moving on, parking is limited at all sites. Meet at small car park at SW corner of New Buckenham Common. (3)	Thu May 17	TM 285 923 Broome Heath (and tetrad recording) <i>Crassula tillaea</i> , <i>Trifolium suffocatum</i> and <i>T. glomeratum</i> have been recorded here in the past. Meet at car park / recycling point in Green Lane off Loddon Road, immediately S of village hall. (6)
		Tue May 22	TL 977 897 Larling Fen Meet here at the roadside for further instructions as we'll be moving on to other locations. (7)
		Thu May 31	TG 419 144 Clippesby Tetrad recording in the Ashby, Oby & Thurne area. Meet at the small parking area on the side of the road, c. 100m west of Hall Farm. (8)

June	TF 912 297 Hempton Marsh Reserve on a date to be fixed. Volunteers please to FS. (9)
Mon June 4	TL 775 940 Cranwich Camp and re-creation areas. Meet at the entrance to the Camp. (10)
Sat June 9	TG 309 370 Mundesley The coast from Mundesley to Bacton. Also to search for <i>Orobanche purpurea</i> . Meet at the free cliff-top car park accessed via Sea View Road (unmade) immediately to the east of Trafalgar Court. (11)
Sun June 17	TG 372 190 How Hill, Ludham NNNS 'Wildflowers Revealed' meeting. Park at How Hill, small fee payable. (12)
Tue June 19	TL 974 904 'C' sites near Larling Fen, carr, meadow and dry woodland. Meet here at the roadside for further instructions as we'll be moving on to other locations. (13)
Fri June 22	TG 341 066 Strumpshaw Common Meet at the RSPB reserve car park and we'll walk through from there. (14)
Thu June 28	TG 265 262 Swanton Abbot Common Meet at Swanton Abbot church. and pm Smallburgh Fen (15)
Tue July 3	TF 906 188 Mileham Water meadows and other habitats by the Nar. West of Mileham on the B1145, turn into the gateway to a meadow. The gateway on the <i>south</i> side of the road is sub-opposite a service road to Mill Farm on the <i>north</i> side of the road. (16) Then if time pm Litcham Common , small car park at TF 887 172
Sat July 7	TG 261 351 Rubus Workshop Southrepps Common With Alec Bull. Meet at the small car park by the common. (17)
Wed July 11	TF 752 128 Narborough Hall Park The entrance to the park is to the south-east of the Hall on Narford Road. (18)
Sat Jul 28	TG 430 105 Stokesby N.b. 9.00 am start To walk from Yarmouth to Stokesby along the north bank of the river Bure. Approximately 11km. Meet at the riverside parking area (by the playground). We will leave some cars here then move on to Yarmouth and walk back. (19)
Thu Aug 2	TG 379 035 Cantley Marshes Meet at Marsh Farm. Cross the railway in Cantley, and turn right and then up the gated lane towards the sewage works and park in the yard. (20)

Thur Aug 9	TF 505 026 Upwell, Outwell and Three Holes – tetrad recording. Plenty of water for those who like it. Meet in the playing-fields car park, which is on the west side of the A1101 (New Road) about a hundred yards south of Upwell Church. (21)
Sat Aug 18	TM 164 928 Forncett Area Tetrad recording (TM19) Meet at Forncett St Peter Church (22)
Thur Aug 23	TF 722 404 Ringstead To record arable weeds at Courtyard Farm. Meet at the car park on the north side of Burnham Road. (23)
Sat Sep 1	TG 069 023 Wicklewood Tetrad recording (TG00) Meet at St Marys church, Wicklewood. (24)
Mon Sep 10	TL 684 991 Wretton area Tetrad recording. Meet at a rough car park south of Wretton on the south side of the Cut-off Channel in Wretton Fen Drove. (25)
Sat Sep 15	TG 427 054 Wickhampton Tetrad recording (TG40) Meet at St Andrews Church, Wickhampton (26)
Sat Sep 22	TG 007 442 Morston Meet at Morston Quay NT car park. Bring NT membership cards or pay a fee. To study late saltmarsh plants with special reference to ecology and identification of <i>Salicornia/Sarcocornia</i> . Wellingtons strongly recommended. Beginners to the identification of saltmarsh plants after flowering welcome. (27) pm TF 965 439 Move to Stiffkey NT car park (free).
